Christian Kuttner studied chemistry at the University of Bayreuth and completed his PhD in 2009 on organic-inorganic interfaces and colloidal materials. He then worked as a post-doctoral researcher at a Leibniz institute in Dresden, focusing on nanostructured optical materials. From 2018 onward, he continued his research in Spain as a Marie Skłodowska-Curie fellow.

He has been with Nature Communications since 2021 and has served as a Senior Editor for the past two and a half years, handling manuscripts in physical chemistry and nano-materials. In 2024, he received the Bundestag Fellowship “Science meets Politics” and spent five months working in the German Parliament.
